You are the proud owner of a beautiful piece of lovingly created art made in Canberra, Australia by Sophie Kristine of Oh Little Spark Art.

This is a Lino print! To make it I carefully carved out a linoleum plate to make an image in relief with beautiful Narex graving chisels. I then inked up the linoleum with a hard rubber brayer, and beautiful, thick jet-black block printing ink. After inking up I carefully transferred the plate to my Grandmother's antique William Collins and Sons (Glasgow) book press to pull the image onto Australian made art paper. After letting it dry thoroughly I used Winsor and Newton Artists watercolours to hand colour the image. I have then given it an edition number, title and signed it with my initials and the year it was made.
