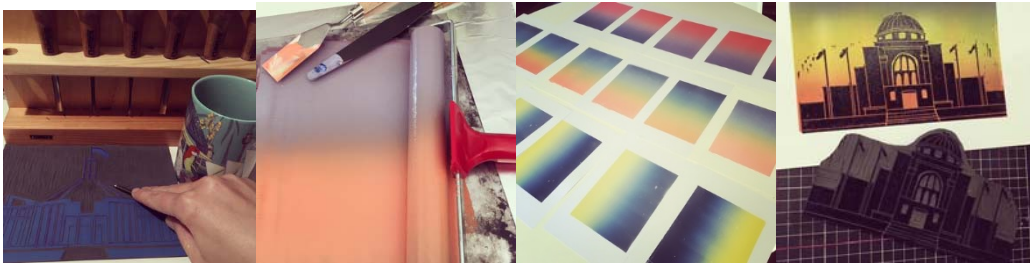


## Congratulations!

You are the proud owner of a beautiful piece of lovingly created art made in Canberra, Australia by Sophie Kristine of Oh Little Spark Art.

This is a multi-block Lino print! To make it I carefully carved out multiple linoleum plates that work together to make an image in relief with beautiful Narex graving chisels. I then inked up the first linoleum plate with a hard rubber brayer to print the base or background layer, in bright colours. After inking up the plate I carefully transferred the plate to my Grandmother's antique William Collins and Sons (Glasgow) book press to pull the image onto Australian made art paper. After letting it dry I carefully aligned and printed each remaining layer. The last plate I printed is called the key plate, with beautiful, thick jet-black block printing ink. I have then given it an edition number, title and signed it with my initials and the year it was made.
